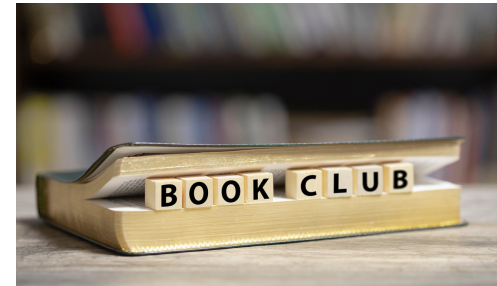

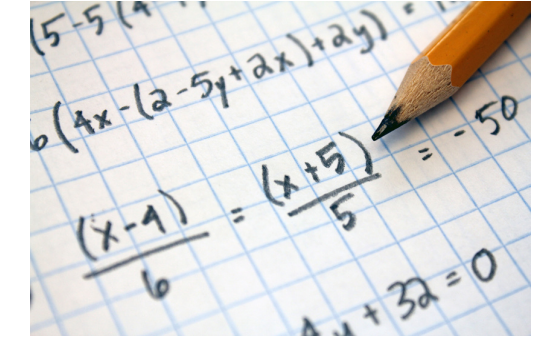


Book Club 7th/8th Grade

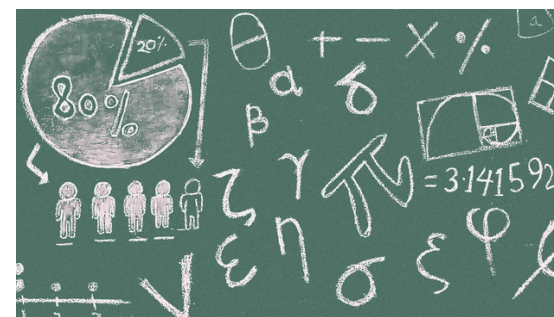


Math Club 5th/6th Grade

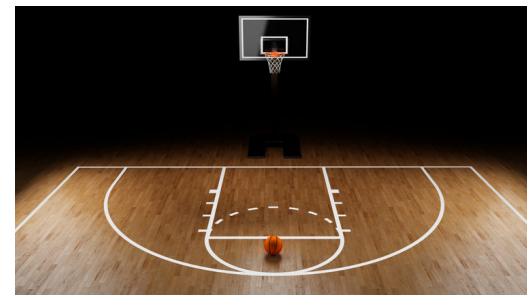

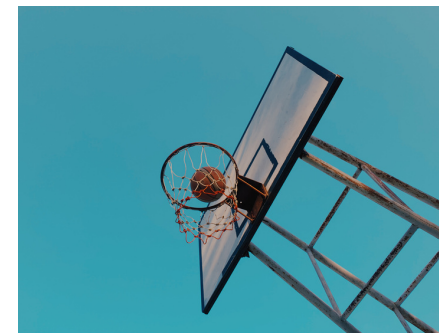


Basketball Skills (Girls 7-8)
